Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, pending trial, in case FIR No.146 dated 13.08.2018 registered under Section 306 of IPC at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 15.08.2018 and the deceased was known to the petitioner for the last about 10 years as they used to work in orchestra and in this manner, friendship developed between them. There is no allegation against the petitioner that he was instrumental in the suicide committed by the deceased.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh, does not dispute the custody and has argued that when the complainant returned to home, his granddaughter Sania met him outside the house

and informed that the petitioner had come to the house of the deceased and has quarrelled with her.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that neither any suicide note was left by the deceased nor there is any such allegation of abetment to commit suicide and the petitioner being in custody since 15.08.2018, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
