This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for habeas corpus seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to release the detenues as mentioned in Para 3 of the petition who were alleged to be in illegal custody of respondents No.4 & 5.

Vide order dated 08.03.2019, District Magistrate, Nawanshahr was asked to ascertain as to whether the person mentioned in this petition is in illegal detention of the said Brick Kiln and if so, he was required to get him released forthwith.

A report of Shri Vinay Bublani, IAS, Deputy Commissioner cum District Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been filed in the Court, in which, it is stated that pursuant to the directions of this Court, a Committee was constituted which visited the premises of respondents No.4

& 5 and it was found that there was no brick kiln by the name of P.G.K. (K.G.F.) as stated in the petition. In fact, a brick kiln by the name of R.G. Brick Kiln was lying closed since June, 2018.

In view of the report, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition may be disposed of as infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
