Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.141 dated 20.10.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

On 29.04.2019, the petitioners were granted the concession of interim bail by this Court as the parties have shown inclination for exploring the possibility of some settlement.

As per the report of the Mediator, no settlement could be arrived at between the parties.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, submits that now the challan stands presented; charges have been framed and even 02 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are 58 and 60 years of age and the parties are closely related, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 29.04.2019 is made absolute.
