Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-bank to inform the fate of One Time Settlement (OTS) arrived at amongst the petitioner and respondent No.3-bank in terms of OTS letter dated 01.12.2017 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.3-bank.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the earlier writ petition was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to either approach the bank or to avail the alternative remedies as were available to him, in accordance with law. Since the petitioner had not approached the bank by filing any representation in writing, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition.
