ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.17 dated 22.02.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner along with 4-5 other persons had entered the house of the complainant and attacked the complainant and his brother. They had hurled brick bats on the complainant which hit on the middle finger of right hand and left elbow of the complainant. The petitioner is alleged to have inflicted 'dat' (sickle) blow on the right elbow of the injured. He also contends that all the injuries on the complainant were blunt and simple in nature.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 14.03.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on

ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sadhu Khan, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 14.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
