Dismissed as withdrawn.

CRM-M-21252-2018

Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.24 dated 12.02.2017, registered under Sections 304-B, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala.

Petitioners were earlier declared innocent. Subsequently, they were summoned under Section 319 of Criminal Procedure Code. They were granted interim bail and thereafter they have joined the proceedings

before the learned trial court. Entire prosecution evidence has been recorded and now case is fixed for defence evidence.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, interim order dated 25.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

However, learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within two months by giving short adjournments.
