AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.11.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-52992 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural (respondent No. 2) to look into the matter and to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) expeditiously. In case, the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon. Further, in case there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation

Annexure P-2 be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural (respondent No. 2) so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.”

Status report dated 9.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Vikram Jeet Duggal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-Rural filed in Court is taken on record. Copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. Along with the reply, compliance report dated 12.4.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the compliance report dated 12.4.2019.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
