JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. This is an appeal that has been filed seeking enhancement of the compensation, as allowed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridabad.
2. Counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 would submit that in fact, the matter has been compromised, therefore, there is no appearance on behalf of the appellants.
3. A perusal of the paper book and the interim orders passed would reflect that as far back as November 2017, there was no one putting in appearance on behalf of the appellants. Consequently, Mr. Aman Dhir,

Legal Aid Counsel was appointed to assist this court on behalf of the appellants. The matter was taken up subsequently on 29.08.2018, on which date no one put in an appearance on behalf of the appellants and again on 05.12.2019 it was noticed that Mr. Aman Dhir, Legal Aid Counsel was not putting in an appearance. The matter has been adjourned for several occasions and none put in appearance for the appellants. However, on 29.10.2019, one Mr. G.S. Gill, Advocate appeared for the appellants and submitted that the matter stands settled whereas, counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 sought more time to place the compromise on the record.

4. Today, again no one put in an appearance on behalf of the appellants whereas, counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 submits that the matter stands compromised between the appellants and respondents No.1 and 2. Counsel for respondent No.3, however, states that the Insurance Company is not party to any such settlement.

5. This matter is being disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, however, leaving it open to the counsel for the appellants to move an appropriate application for recalling of this order within 03 months, in case, the matter requires to be re-agitated.
