Instant petition is at the hands of Ludhiana Jewellers Association (Regd.) seeking directions to ensure that the police personnel in the State of Punjab do not harass individuals, who are carrying bullion or gold ornaments, diamonds and diamond jewelry inspite of possessing necessary documents in the nature of tax invoices/bills etc.

In the considered view of this Court such a prayer would be open for examination only in proceedings initiated at the hands of any individual, who may have been so harassed and by bringing forth all the necessary details.

At this stage, a prayer is made for withdrawal of the instant petition and with liberty to raise such a grievance at the hands of the so called effected individual.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
