Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.014 dated 01.02.2019 under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 13.03.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, does not dispute the aforesaid fact. However, he states that recovery of gold articles is yet to be effected in the case.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, she being

mother-in-law of the complainant and the bail application of Jagdeep Singh, husband of the complainant, i.e. CRM-M-22105-2019 is pending consideration, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.03.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
