Prayer in this petition is for issuance a direction to Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to take up the investigation in FIR No.156 dated 07.09.2015 filed under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana or to transfer the same to some other independent agency and further to direct the investigating agency to submit final report before the Court and also to restrain the respondents from harassing the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5.

Learned State counsel on the basis of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Gill-Rural), Ludhiana dated 09.08.2017, has

submitted that the investigation is complete and the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C stand presented before the Illaqa Magistrate on 13.06.2017 and the case is now fixed for arguments on framing of the charge.

This factual position is not disputed by the counsel for the petitioner as well as the counsel representing the private respondents.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the parties to approach the trial Court for redressal of their grievances.
