Petitioner Gurpreet Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.188 dated 25.12.2017, registered at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 307 IPC has been added subsequently.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner was empty handed and only kick and fist blows are attributed to him. The injury under Section 307 IPC has been attributed to co-accused Baggi.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 14.03.2019, passed by

this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from him. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 14.03.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
