Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.70 dated 24.02.2018 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

There are serious allegations of cheating. The petitioner is a property broker who is alleged to have connived with impersonator facilitating the sale of property belonging to a Non-Resident Indian. Huge amount of ₹60,00,000/- has been paid by the complainant. In such situation, this Court does not find that the petitioner is entitled to concession of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
