ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.113 dated 13.06.2017, under Sections 302 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was found innocent during investigation and has been implicated as she is the mother of main accused Tara Singh, who along with his wife Indu Bala is in custody. Petitioner is 61 years old lady and is not involved in any other case. The body of the deceased, who was allegedly friend of Tara Singh was recovered from the house where the petitioner and her family members are residing. In the medical opinion with regard to the cause of death, it was mentioned that the death had occurred due to consumption of organo phosphorous compound.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 13.03.2019, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and in the event of her doing so, she was ordered to be released on interim bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, states that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail in terms of the order dated 13.03.2019.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 61 years old lady and found innocent during trial, the order dated 13.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
