The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.65, dated 21.2.2015, registered under Sections 21, 22, 29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was on regular bail and he missed only one date and thereafter he himself surrendered and has now been in custody for one year and about five months. No other case is pending against the petitioner.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has undergone custody of one year four months and twenty eight days.

Learned DAG Punjab has accepted these factual assertions but has argued that the evidence is well under way.

Be that as it may, once it is accepted that the petitioner was earlier on regular bail and missed only one occasion, the same can be condoned. In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
