ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 75 dated 12.02.2019 under Sections 15 (2) and 15 (3) (wrongly mentioned as 15(13) in the impugned order) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and Section 304-A IPC (Section 304-II IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sector -10 Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner is that he had wrongly administered injection to the son of the complainant who had expired due to allergic reaction. He further contends that the petitioner is a qualified paramedic to administer injection. There is no other case against the petitioner.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 20.03.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, City Gurugram filed by the learned State counsel is taken on record. Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Anil, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 20.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
