Writ petition has been filed seeking the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to provide benefits to labourers under the Labour Welfare Schemes approved under Rule 265 of the Punjab Rules 2008 framed under the Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Act, 1996.
2. Learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has placed on record orders dated 03.05.2019 issued by the Deputy Secretary Punjab, Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board issuing Pension Payment Order in favour of the following persons:
