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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking a mandamus for directing the respondent authorities to pay to him compensation amounting to Rs.10,00,000/- apart from the expenses incurred for medical treatment on account of an accident that is stated to have taken place on 18.09.2018 involving a stray animal and in which the petitioner suffered injuries.

The instant petition raises questions of fact.

There is no conclusive evidence on record for this Court to record a finding that the injuries suffered by the petitioner were on account of an accident involving a stray animal. In such like claims evidence would have to be led. Such matters cannot be gone into by this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction.

As such without making any observations as regards the merits of the case/claim, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail of his other alternate remedies in accordance with law.
