This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.13 dated 15.02.2018 registered under Section 323 IPC and 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa further added Section 325 IPC vide DDR dated 28.02.2018.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that she has no objection.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before 08.04.2019 and moves an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 12.04.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
