Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (*for short 'Cr.P.C.'*) for grant of bail, pending trial, to the petitioner in case FIR No.96 dated 12.10.2016, under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, has pointed out that entire prosecution evidence is over and it is only for the petitioner to take his own time for concluding the defence evidence, if any.

If that be so, no ground for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner is made out. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
