The present petition has been filed for a direction to the official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.177 dated 16.4.2017, registered at Police Station City Sonipat, under Sections 306, 34 IPC.

Learned State counsel submits that after filing of this petition, the challan has been presented in Court against respondent No.6 and trial is in progress.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the challan is incomplete and based upon a flawed investigation. Respondents No.7 and 8 are also liable and should have been named as accused.

In view of the fact that the challan has been presented against respondent No.6 and that the trial is in progress, I do not deem it appropriate to continue any further with this petition.

The same is dismissed. In case the petitioner is aggrieved by the investigation, he would be at liberty to seek further investigation by invoking the jurisdiction of the trial Court concerned.
