Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No. 98 dated 9.5.2017 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, 506 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala alongwith consequential proceedings.

On 27.3.2019 following order was passed:-

“Service complete.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of respondent No.2 is taken on record. Be tagged at the appropriate place.

Learned State counsel contends that this petition is not maintainable unless and until, the petitioners appear before the trial Court, after their absence on 14.05.2018 i.e. since last 10 months. Now, they have been summoned through non-bailable warrants by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the petitioners are

directed to appear before the trial Court within two weeks' from today and their bail application(s), if any, shall be decided within reasonable time, failing which petition shall be dismissed for want of prosecution.

Adjourned to 05.09.2019.

However, it is also clarified that this order shall not be an embargo in conducting the proceedings against the petitioners under Section 446 Cr.P.C., by the trial Court.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 is directed to file Vakalatnama, on or before the date fixed.”

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 has submitted that petitioners have not complied with the aforesaid order.

Even the counsel for the petitioners is not present. In view thereof, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
