The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.13, dated 16.1.2019, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, at Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana.

Counsel for the parties state that the compromise dated 20.5.2019 has been effected between the parties. A copy thereof is taken on record as Mark `A'. Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Gian Singh, has accepted that the matter has been compromised.

Counsel for the complainant further states that the petitioner should undertake that he would implement the compromise. The petitioner

who is present in person states that he would be bound by the compromise.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
