The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.97 dated 26.05.2015 registered under Sections 406 and 506 IPC at Police Station Pillu Khera, District Jind.

Brief facts of the case are that marriage of petitioner No.7 was solemnized with Pooja-respondent No.3 on 02.05.2007 according to Hindu Rites and Ceremonies at Jind and out of the wedlock, one daughter namely Jahanvi was born on 25.01.2009. Thereafter respondent No.3 lodged an FIR No.244 dated 25.04.2012 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506/34 IPC at Police Station City, Jind, against petitioner No.7 as well as his parents. It transpires that matter was settled by way of a compromise wherein petitioner No.1 being known to both the parties, agreed to pay an amount of Rs.10.00 lacs to Pooja-respondent No.3 as full and final settlement for mutual divorce. Now, again respondent No.2, i.e, father of respondent No.3 has lodged the present FIR under Sections 406/506 IPC alleging harassment

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajbir Singh, has apprised the Court that after investigation in the matter, cancellation report has been prepared and submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction and which is pending for consideration.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for quashing of the FIR in question. Consequently, the petition is disposed off as such. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to raise all their pleas before the Illaqa Magistrate where the cancellation report is pending for consideration.
