This review application has been filed by the petitioners claiming that they were not heard as they had referred to numerous judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court as mentioned in the review application, which have not been considered by this Court while adjudicating the issue involved.

After hearing learned Counsel for the review petitioners, I am of the opinion that the instant review application deserves to be dismissed.

It is not necessary for a Judge to refer and cite all the judgments referred by the Counsel or a party, when there is no dispute regarding the proposition laid down in the said judgments. In view of the contents of the review application, in which I could find reference to judgments only, I am

reminded of another judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court titled as

Padmausundra Rao & Anr. Vs. State of Tamil Nadu & Ors. 2002(3) SCC 533, whereby it has been authoritatively held that peculiar facts and circumstances of each case are to be examined, considered and appreciated first, before applying any codified or judge-made law thereto. Each case is to be decided as per its own peculiar fact situation. Sometimes, difference of even one additional fact or circumstance can make the world of difference.

Applying the aforesaid principle on the instant case, especially the assertions made by petitioners in their writ petition as also in the instant review application, whereby similar claims were considered in detail by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and thereafter negated in review applications filed in **Orissa Lift Irrigation Corporation Ltd. Vs. Rabi Sankar Patro & Ors.** Vide their order dated 22.01.2018, no ground is made out for reviewing the order dated 10.12.2018 passed by this Court.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the instant review application, the same is hereby dismissed.
