Petitioner filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus for directing the respondent authorities under the State of Punjab to release the requisite amount/benefit under the *Kanya Jagriti Jyoti Scheme*.

On a previous date of hearing a complete copy of the writ paper book had been furnished to learned State counsel so as to complete instructions in the matter.

During the course of resumed hearing today, learned State counsel upon instructions from Sh. Taranjit Singh, Superintendent has taken a stand that as per rules governing the scheme in question the petitioner lacks eligibility and as such, is not entitled to the benefit.
