Report dated 28.09.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent Manpreet Kaur and accused/petitioners-Anish Dhiman and Sunita Dhiman through their attorney Parshat Dhiman and Parshat Dhiman, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure

The private parties to this petition have put in appearance before this Court and during the course of interaction with the parties, it transpired that they have compromised the matter and resolved to end the dispute. Their statements regarding compromise has also been recorded.

Heard.

In the light of statements made by the parties and the fact

that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 10 dated 17.12.2016 registered at Police Station NRI District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120-B IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner is quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
