Although as per office report, notice issued to the respondent has not been received back served or otherwise, however, keeping in view the controversy involved, this Court is of the view that the present petition can be disposed of.

The petitioners through the present petition challenges the order dated 01.03.2018 (Annexure P-4) through which the petitioner was declared proclaimed person under Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in view of the fact that he had not appeared before the Court on a particular date of hearing i.e. jumped the bail. The petitioner has relied upon Annexure P-5, a report of ultrasonography to assert that the mother of the petitioners was undergoing treatment.

Purpose of declaring the proclaimed persons is to secure their presence in the proceedings pending before the Court. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner would appear before the trial

Court within 10 days and apply for regular bail. If such an application is filed, learned trial Court would release the petitioner after granting him regular bail on its satisfaction subject to furnishing of personal bonds and surety bonds.

The petition is disposed of.
