KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the judgment dated 27.04.2010 of the Hon'ble Apex Court, rendered in Civil Appeal No.3879 of 2010 (Punjab Roadways Moga through its General Manager Vs. Punja Sahib Bus and Transport Co. & Ors.), the regular permit being claimed by the petitioner on the route in question cannot be granted in view of Section 104 of the Motor Vehicles Act. In view of the settled legal proposition by the pronouncement of the Hon'ble Apex Court since the relief prayed for is not liable to be granted. The petition accordingly stands dismissed.
