Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for issuance of directions to the respondents not to harass the petitioner, as he is not connected with FIR No.150 dated 21.10.2013 under Sections 363, 366, 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the complainant and the prosecutrix have already made statements before the police that the petitioner is the son of uncle of the complainant as well as the prosecutrix. He further submits that since the petitioner has not been named in the FIR, he is not an accused in the present FIR, but still the police is harassing him, for which, the petitioner has moved an application dated 06.05.2018 to respondent no.2-SSP, Hoshiarpur.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2-SSP, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation dated 06.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) and act in accordance with law.
