AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C quashing of FIR No. 66 dated 3.4.2006 registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC, at Police Station City Kot Kapura, District Faridkot and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

The ground taken is that apart from the FIR the complainant had filed a private complaint also and the petitioners have been convicted for that case and it is therefore prayed that present FIR be quashed. Reply has been filed by the respondent-State wherein this essential fact has been admitted. It has further been mentioned that that FIR was clubbed with the present case and therefore with the conviction of the petitioners both the cases come to an end and the present petition is infructuous.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands infructuous.
