Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 407 Cr.P.C. is to set aside the order dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Sessions Judge, Sangrur, vide which, the cases i.e. (i) “State Versus Gurpreet Singh” in FIR No.72 dated 06.06.2013 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur, pending before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam has been wrongly transferred to the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sangrur; and (ii) “Gagandeep Kaur Versus Gurpreet Singh” pending before the court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sunam, has been transferred to the court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur.

Memorandum of appearance filed on behalf of respondents

No.1 and 2 in court today, is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the cases have been transferred to Additional Civil Judge and not to the Judicial Magistrate.

This Court finds that this argument is totally misconceived. In the State of Punjab, every Civil Judge has been entrusted with the power of Judicial Magistrate as well.

No ground for interference is made out.
