The present petition has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.435 dated 01.09.2017, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar alongwith all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-1) entered into between the parties.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

On instructions from ASI Inderjeet Singh, learned State counsel has acknowledged the said factum of compromise. Also contends that after conducting the investigation in the FIR in question the untraced report has already been prepared and the same shall be submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction within a period of two weeks.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to the issued in the matter and the same is disposed of as such.

Needless to say that as and when report is submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction the same be considered expeditiously.
