Instant petition has been filed seeking a Mandamus for commanding the respondents to renew/issue him a Passport.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Placed on record at Annexure P-8 is a letter dated 22.1.2016 issued by the Govt. of India, Ministry of External Affairs, Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh and addressed to the petitioner and a perusal thereof makes it clear that the Passport application of the petitioner is pending on account of non-submission of required documents/explanation.

Counsel was repeatedly called upon to advert to the documents issued by the concerned Passport Authority requiring him to submit certain documents as also to furnish an explanation.

Counsel submits that he is not in possession of such documents/letter.

In the absence of the necessary particulars/documents, the prayer made in the instant petition cannot be entertained.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.

However, it would be open for the petitioner to agitate the matter afresh after placing on record all the relevant documents.
