Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 17.03.2018, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he was not named in the FIR and no recovery was effected from the present petitioner but the same was effected from the co-accused. After investigation, challan was presented before the trial Court and trial is going on.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner is involved in one more case under NDPS Act which was registered on 21.09.2017.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner has already joined the investigation. After investigation, challan was presented before the trial Court and trial is going on. As such, the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 23.05.2018 for release of petitioner on interim bail stands made absolute and petition is disposed of.
