This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.152 dated 22.12.2016, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC registered at Police Station PS Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all other consequent proceedings on the basis of compromise.

As per the FIR there was a huge scam of providing fake sureties in Court. In that scam one of the main accused is one Balwinder Singh s/o Gurdial Singh, r/o Village Pippal Mangholi, City Rajpura, Patiala, Punjab.

The precise allegation against the petitioner is that he identified

Balwinder Singh. Both the learned DAG and the counsel for respondent

No.2 have accepted that the person who was identified was actually Balwinder Singh and it was not a case where some other persons had been identified by the petitioner as Balwinder Singh. As regards the petitioner no offence can be pointed out.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of and the above said FIR and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner alone.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
