The present petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 28.02.2019, passed by the Rent Controller, Ludhiana (for short, the Rent Controller), dismissing the application of the petitioner for recalling PW1 Pawan Dhanda for further cross examination.

While praying for setting aside the order, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that one relevant question with respect to a personal necessity was not put to the witness and therefore, the said witness should be allowed to be recalled for further cross examination.

A perusal of the order dated 28.02.2019, dismissing the application of the petitioner shows that, the Rent Controller has correctly noticed that the said application has been filed only to linger on the proceedings and to fill up the lacunae, which cannot be allowed. The witness cannot be allowed to be recalled only on account of change of the counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to point any infirmity in the well reasoned order dated 28.02.2019, passed by the Rent Controller.

Dismissed accordingly.
