The Director-cum-Estate Officer, Central Forensic Science Laboratory, Chandigarh, has filed the instant petition seeking quashing of the consumer complaint bearing No.CC/700/2018 (Annexure P-1) as also the proceedings arising therefrom including an order dated 13.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum-II, Chandigarh and in terms of which the petitioner had been restrained from issuing any orders of eviction of the government accommodation that had been occupied by respondent No.2.

Suffice it to observe that respondent No.2 had been allotted official accommodation i.e. House No.703, Ground Floor, Sector 36-B, Chandigarh and he had superannuated on 30.09.2018.

Counsel representing respondent No.2 makes a statement at bar that the impugned complaint filed by respondent No.2 has since been

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withdrawn on 28.03.2019.

Further statement is made that the premises in question would be vacated within a period of two weeks from today.

Statement of counsel representing respondent No.2 is accepted.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in the instant writ petition, same is disposed of as infructuous.
