Petitioner seeks a mandamus directing respondent No.2 i.e. the Regional Passport Officer, Amritsar to take a final decision on an application dated 17.12.2018 that had been submitted for issuance of a passport and received in the office of respondent No.2 on 18.01.2019.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Advocate, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and waives service.

A complete copy of the writ petition already stands furnished to counsel for respondents No.1 and 2.

Statement of Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, Advocate representing respondents No.1 and 2 is recorded to the effect that in case the application dated 17.12.2018 submitted by the petitioner for issuance of a passport is pending as of date, the same would be processed in accordance with law and under the provisions of the Passport Act, 1967 and rules framed thereunder and a final decision would be taken expeditiously and in any case within a period of four weeks from today and conveyed to the petitioner.

In the light of such statement made by counsel representing the respondent/authorities, no further directions are required to be passed.
