GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to comply with provisions of 160 Cr.P.C.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that FIR No.21 dated 6.2.2019 under Sections 302, 307, 324, 148, 149, 109, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, Police Station New Baradari, Jalandhar was registered at the instance of Kamalpreet Singh @ Babbu pertaining to murder of his brother Baba wherein all the persons named as accused in the FIR have been arrested. It is alleged that the police is somehow now raiding

house of the petitioner so as to falsely implicated his son as accused despite the fact his son does not figure in the FIR.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station New Baradari, Jalandhar that in case, the petitioner is required to be associated with any inquiry or investigation or some information is to be elicited from him, then a written advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 be served upon him.
4. A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.3- SHO, Police Station New Baradari, Jalandhar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
