By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 195 dated 20.4.2018, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station S.G.M. Nagar (Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Nagar), District Faridabad, Haryana.

On 23.5.2018, this Court had passed the following order :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to execute the sale deed in favour of the complainant on payment of balance amount by the complainant.

Notice of motion for 03.08.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation. Under such circumstances, the petitioner is directed to join investigation by contacting the Investigating Officer within 5 days from today and render all sort of cooperation. The petitioner has to surrender his Passport before the Investigating Officer, if he has got one, otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard. If, in the meanwhile, he is arrested, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 23.05.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Jaipal Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.05.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
