Petitioner M.P.Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in criminal complaint No.6/2018 dated 29.01.2018 titled as Dr. Gobind Gupta Vs. Engineer Abhijeet Bhagat and others, under Sections 14, 14A, 18, 19, 19-A, 20 and 21 of the Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissue Act, 1994

Notice of motion was issued.

Respondent served, but none has appeared on his behalf.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

The petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court within 15 days from the date of last order i.e. 20.03.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

The petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation as this is a complaint case. He is simply to face the trial of the complaint case

before the trial Court. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 20.03.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
