By way of filing the present application under Order 47 Rule
1 CPC, applicant Mamta Sharma seeks review of order dated 05.03.2019,
passed by this Court in CR-1486-2019.

Inter alia, in the application, it is contended that the civil
revision pending before this Court was withdrawn on 05.03.2019,
however, there are various arguable points and other justifiable reasons
for disposal of the revision petition on merits. In support of his
arguments, learned counsel has referred to judgment **Teja Singh Vs.**
Union Territory of Chandigarh and others, AIR 1982 P&H 169.

I have heard learned senior counsel for the applicants besides
going through the record and I find that there is no ground for reviewing
the order, since the revision petition itself had been withdrawn by counsel

for the applicants, making statement in the Court. The application does not fall within four corners of Order 47 of CPC. The judgment cited is also not applicable due to different facts and circumstances and the context in which such observations had been made. The application being without merit stands dismissed.
