Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the trial Court including his submission to the effect that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and that the petitioner had not benefited from any amount allegedly allegedly given to Dilraj Singh; and also his submission to the effect that in fact Dilraj Singh having admitted his guilt, no allegation would survive against the present petitioner since the entire amount had ultimately been received by Dilraj Singh; and also his submission to the effect that even in the Inquiry Report nothing incriminating had been found against the petitioner; and also his submission to the effect that the petitioner has never been ever involved in any other identical case.

In view of aforesaid submission, the petition is disposed off as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the aforesaid submissions before trial Court at appropriate stage. The trial Court is directed to expedite

the trial keeping in view the advanced stage of the petitioner. The trial Court while deciding the matter shall also examine the effect of the confession made by the co-accused who had admittedly received the amount of ₹ 5.5 lacs.
