Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for direction to official respondents not to harass the petitioners at the behest of private respondents and protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners. And further if the presence of petitioners or their family members is required in the inquiry, prior notice of 7 days under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3—Assistant Inspector General of Police, Ludhiana (Punjab) is directed to look into representation dated 03.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioners, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after

perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3—Assistant Inspector General of Police, Ludhiana (Punjab), to look into representation dated 03.03.2019 (Annexure P-1), moved by the petitioners and do the needful, if required.
