Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.85 dated 20.07.2018 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody since 23.07.2018. It is further submitted that challan was presented on 10.01.2019; charges were framed on 20.04.2019 and till date, no prosecution witness has been examined, therefore, it will take long time in conclusion of the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that next date for recording the prosecution evidence is 21.12.2019.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the custody of the petitioner, which is more than 01 year and 05 months, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
