Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.05 dated 09.01.2019, registered at Police Station Division-B, Amritsar, under Sections 307, 365, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

On 14.03.2019, a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:

“The learned counsel submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Notice of motion for 20.05.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also

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abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 14.03.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
