The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0013 dated 13.01.2019, registered under Sections 354, 354-A, 354-D, 363, 511 and 506 IPC at Police Station Zirakpur, District Mohali.

As per the FIR, the victims are students of Public Memorial School, Zirakpur. Petitioner was deployed as Driver in a different school. It is alleged that petitioner-Sandeep Singh and co-accused Krishna used to harass them and caught hold their arms and tried to make them to sit in the van and threatened them that if they tell to anyone, then they would finish whole of the family.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused

14.03.2019 passed in CRM-M-11014-2019.

The petitioner is in custody since 13.01.2019. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Sandeep Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
