Pursuant to order dated 27.9.2019, Mr. Amar Deep Jain, HCS, SDM, Samalkha is present in Court and tenders his unconditional apology which is accepted. His Bail bonds be released.

Learned State counsel states that application for refund of the petitioner has been decided by the Estate Officer, Faridabad vide order dated 14.10.2019 and the claim is rejected at this stage, as the matter is pending before the Supreme Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the directions were for respondents No. 2 to 4 to decide the representation. He further states that the petitioner would be satisfied if order is passed by the Chief Administrator.

In the writ petition respondent No.2 was HUDA through Chief Administrator, respondent No.3 was Administrator, HUDA, Faridabad and respondent No.4 was Estate Officer, HUDA, Faridabad.

Learned State counsel on instructions states that needful will be

done within four weeks from today.

In view of above statement, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law if still aggrieved of the order.
