Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.3 and 4 to investigate FIR No.138 dated 01.02.2018 under Sections 506 and 509 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat in a fair and proper manner.

Reply in the case has already been filed by Satish Kumar Gautam, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Panipat on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. As per the reply, preliminary investigation of the case was conducted by L/SI Gyatri Devi No.10/PPT, Police Station City Panipat and statement of the petitioner under Section 164 Cr.PC was recorded before the Magistrate. Thereafter, the investigation of the case was transferred to SHO Police Station Women, Panipat and further investigation was conducted by L/ASI Seema No.155/PPT, Police Station Women, Panipat.

The reply further reveals that on 10.07.2018, both the parties including the petitioner, her husband Ram Kumar, Rajpal and Rishi Ram as well as the opposite party i.e. Ishwer, Hawa Singh, Ram Mehar, Satyawar and Vikram were thoroughly interrogated in the police station. The investigation was duly verified by Meena Devi, SHO Police Station Women, Paniapt. Thereafter, on the basis of evidence, statements and documents so available, the police has prepared a cancellation report on 03.10.2018.

Considering the prayer of the petitioner for fair investigation of the case and the reply submitted by respondents No.1 to 4 that they have prepared a cancellation report in the case, this Court finds that prayer of the petitioner stands redressed.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner is not satisfied with the cancellation report, she is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
